# MICKLEPAGE

*An old farmhouse and barn, with a unique barn-chapel and grounds in the heart of the Sussex country side amid a wonderful network of rural footpaths. Available for retreats, holidays, meetings and family groups of up to 26 people on a self-catering basis.*

This quiet space is maintained and managed by a christian charitable trust. The original house is a typical 14th century medieval hall house. In the 17th century the barn was built near the house.



The Micklepage Trustees and Council carry on the work of the original members of the community who lived, farmed, and taught here.

While the Trustees and Council manage and care for the property, there is no resident warden. Groups who come here look after themselves for both catering and housework.

The community was founded to link town and country, with special emphasis on families from city parishes.

This work now continues in a wider context. Groups from different backgrounds come for study, prayer, retreat, arts, drama and awaydays. They come to find a place to relax, unwind and come closer to each other and God in many different ways.

Look around Micklepage and you can see that it has been built and kept standing over the centuries not only by professional builders, but by the people who have lived here. In recent years, working parties of those who love the place have carried out all the jobs that need to be done to maintain the property.



### **Farmhouse** Sleeps 14 people in single beds



#### **Downstairs**

- large kitchen/dining room with oil-fired aga which heats hot water
- sitting room with open fire
- 3 bedrooms (2 each with 2 beds, and 1 with 1 bed)
- shower and washbasin
- lavatory

#### **Upstairs**

- 4 bedrooms (2 with 3 beds, 1 with 2 beds, 1 with 1 bed)
- bathroom with bath, washbasin and lavatory

### **Barn** Sleeps 12 people in single beds



#### **Downstairs**

- large kitchen/dining room
- large sitting room with wood-burning stove
- bathroom, with bath and basin
- 2 lavatories with basins

#### **Upstairs**

- 4 bedrooms (1 with 6 beds, 1 with 3 beds, 1 with 2 beds and 1 with 1 bed)

## **Facilities**

- We provide**
- basic cooking and mealtime equipment, including tea towels blankets and pillows
  - logs for open fire (*farmhouse*) and wood-burning stove (*barn*)

- You provide**
- sleeping bags/duvets/sheets, pillowcases, towels and soap!
